PROPOSED DIVESTMENT OF 73 TUAS SOUTH AVENUE 1

Singapore, 29 January 2024 – Mapletree Logistics Trust Management Ltd., as manager (the “Manager”) of Mapletree Logistics Trust (“MLT” or the “Trust”), would like to announce that HSBC Institutional Trust Services (Singapore) Limited (in its capacity as trustee of MLT) has entered into a Purchase Agreement with an unrelated third party for the proposed divestment of 73 Tuas South Avenue 1 in Singapore (“the Property”) at a sale price of S\$16.8 million. JTC Corporation has granted in-principle approval for the transaction subject to the parties complying with the stipulated conditions.

The proposed divestment is in line with the Manager’s strategy to rejuvenate its portfolio through selective divestments. Capital released from the divestment will provide MLT with greater financial flexibility to pursue investment opportunities in high specification, modern logistics facilities with higher growth potential.

The Property is a 22-year-old four-storey cargo lift warehouse with a net lettable area of approximately 10,967 square metres. The sale price of S\$16.8 million is 10.5% above the latest valuation of S\$15.2 million as at 1 January 2024.

The proposed divestment is expected to be completed by FY23/24. It is not expected to have a material impact on MLT’s net asset value and net property income for FY23/24. Following the divestment, MLT’s portfolio will consist of 185 properties¹.

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About Mapletree Logistics Trust (MLT)

MLT, the first Asia-focused logistics REIT in Singapore, was listed on the SGX-ST Main Board on 28 July 2005. MLT’s principal strategy is to invest in a diversified portfolio of income-producing logistics real estate and real estate-related assets. As at 31 December 2023, it has a portfolio of 187 properties in Singapore, Australia, China, Hong Kong SAR, India, Japan, Malaysia, South Korea and Vietnam
